The Board of Commissioners, HICKSVILLE WATER DISTRICT, wishes to notify its consumers that they have increased water rate charges, effective January 1, 1987. The new quarterly rates will reflect in billings beginning April 1, 1987. The rates are as follows:

10 thousand gallons or under \$7.50 minimum
11 to 30 thousand gallons \$1.20 per thousand
over 30 thousand gallons \$1.50 per thousand

The above rates have been adopted with the feeling that consumers will sincerely try to conserve the consumption of water, if the rates better reflect the cost of production.

The Board also agreed to the purchase of "Water Saving Kits" to be sent to all District consumers. The kit is to assist in water conservation to help us stay within the Department of Environmental Conservation recently imposed caps.

gram Director; Irma Weffel, Senior Social Work Therapist and Barbara Helkowski, Social Work Therapist.

The film to be shown is entitled "The Last Prom". The emphasis of the film is drinking and driving.

The presentation will include all types of substance abuse, including alcohol, marijuana, crack and cocaine. There will be time for questions as well as a discussion on what to look for regarding teenage substance abuse and what to do if you suspect someone is abusing alcohol or drugs.

Admission is free and both teenagers and adults are welcome.

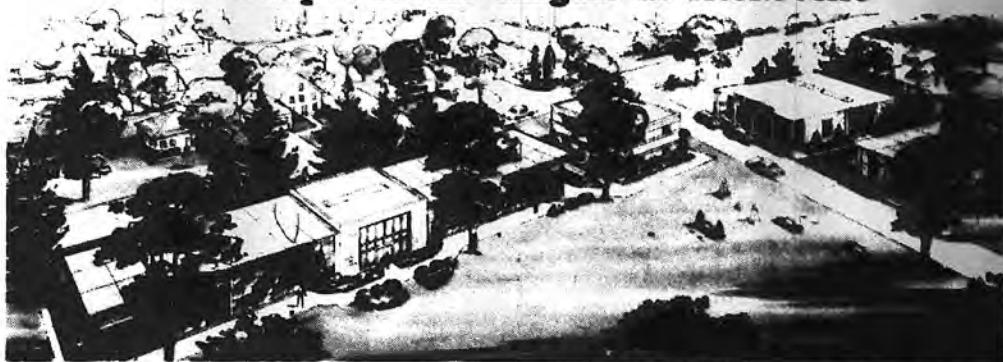
