Kiwanis Club Honors Murphy




During the time when the Kiwanis Memorial Fountain was being built, Bill Murphy was at the site every day in the capacity of Supervisor of Construction.





House Calls By EDITH LANK

Sister Paid Top Price

Dear Edith: My sister recently purchased a house that was multiplelisted. In the course of negotiations, it e down to her and another party bidding on the property. The listing broker told my sister the other party was a broker who wanted the property for himself and had offered to forego his share of the commission. So in trying to get the most for his client. the listing broker advised my sister to up her offer. My sister's broker was relatively

new and this all seemed over his head. I have a problem with this from an ethical standpoint. I feel my sister was taken advantage of and paid too high a price for the property.—Mr. H.B. Unless someone lied to your sister, she

has no complaint. A bidding situation isn't pleasant, but the broker is legally obligated to get the highest price for the seller. The person you refer to as your sister's agent was working for the seller—both agents were. They did, however, have a

legal obligation to be honest and straighforward with buyers. If what they told your sister was true, they were acting properly. How would she feel if she hadn't been told what was going on, and had lost out to the other bidder?

If she really paid too much, the bank's appraisal (for her mortgage application) should have uncovered that fact

Roll Over or Exclusion

Dear Edith: A friend is visiting us from out of state and we are having quite an argument. We want to buy a smaller house and take that \$125,000 exclusion on the sale of this one. We've been here 29 years and I am 58. Our friend says we can only use it if we don't buy another home, otherwise we must roll over our profit into the next home.—Mr. and Mrs. W. K.

Your friend is wrong, If you were under and bought another house, you would roll over your profit (postpone income tax) if you bought another home of equal or greater value within two years. At your age, though, you are free to choose. You can roll over your profit (it doesn't matter what you do with the exact dollars you receive), or pick this time to take the once-in-alifetime exclusion. You can use it whether or not you buy a replacement home.


