Fluroscope Is By means of the X-ray or the fluroroscope, which is a machine that throws a light through the chest, outlining the lung shadows on a special screen, doctors are able to detect suspicions or actual cases of the disease.

New County Charter Provides Inferior Court System; Justices Work Hard To Prepare for January 1

Extensive work has been done in the preparation of new forms for the use of the courts as provided in the Nassau county charter which the voters of the county, acting under a special enactment of the state legislature, adopted in 1936.

Must Be Ready Jan. 1

All must be in readiness on January 1, because the work of the district courts — replacing the justice of the peace courts — must be ready to handle the cases. There can be supported to the peace court in the administration of justice.
