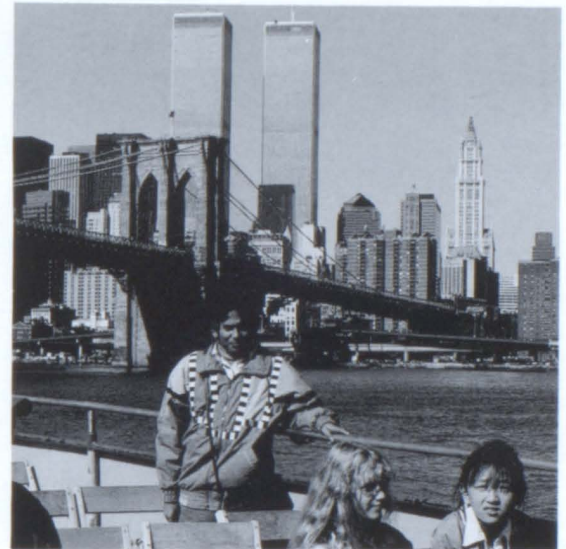
Look At Us, We're Just Chillin' On The Boat And Having A Good Time
